The meeting of the Security Committee was held on February 20, 2018 at 1:00 pm in the Commissioner's Room.

Jerome Kramer called the meeting to order at 1:15 p.m. Present were Jerome Kramer, Bill Henry, Tammy White, Julie Stenger, Booker Boyer, Michelle Gurciullo, Roland Kramer, Les Green. Absent is Brandon Myers. Guests present were Jeff Higgins.

Jerome Kramer announced the Open Meeting Act with amendments is posted for public review and the Security Committee will comply with the open meeting requirements.

Henry moved to approve the order of the Agenda. Stenger seconded. Roll Call Vote: Jerome Kramer-aye, Bill Henry-aye, Tammy White-aye, Julie Stenger-aye, Les Green-absent, Booker Boyer-aye, Michelle Gurciullo-aye, Roland Kramer-aye, Brandon Myers-absent. Nays none. Motion carried.

Rolly Kramer moved to approve the minutes of February 6, 2018 meeting. Henry seconded. Discussion on security equipment, procedures, signage, parking and public announcements.

Discussion about outside attorneys being allowed to bypass security with appropriate ID's. Brandon stated he would be able to print those for the attorneys, they would be a different color code and the attorneys would need to complete paperwork. It was discussed to not allow the attorneys to bypass and can be reevaluated after security is implemented.

Custodial staff would be able to exit any door after 5:30 p.m. County Attorney may need to add a lock inside the office for employee secure entrance.
