Commissioner Bruns stated that the current pipeline is being retrofitted as was approved by FERC. Lincoln County did a resolution in 2022 in support of the pipeline but had no authority in approval or disapproval.

Commissioner Woodruff said that there are pros and cons to the pipeline, but the County Board felt the pros outweighed the cons.

Motion by Weems, seconded by Bruns to authorize the Chairman to sign the state grant award and special conditions for the Second Opportunity Supplemental 2023 Community-based Juvenile Services Aid Enhancement grant in the amount of \$1,190.00 to purchase 10 Chromebooks for one of the support programs. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.
