Meeting of the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners. Present were Commissioners Joe Hewgley, Kent Weems, Micaela Wuehler, Chris Bruns, and County Clerk, Rebecca Rossell. Bruns offered prayer. Weems called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. Commissioner Woodruff was absent.

Vice Chairman Weems announced the Open Meeting Act with amendments is posted for public review and the county board will comply with the open meeting requirements.

Motion by Hewgley, seconded by Wuehler to approve the minutes regarding the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners meeting held on February 13, 2023. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, and Wuehler voted "aye". Nays, none. Woodruff absent. Bruns abstained.

Motion by Hewgley, seconded by Wuehler to receive and order filed the treasurer's receipts. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler and Bruns voted "aye". Nays, none. Woodruff absent.

Motion by Bruns, seconded by Hewgley to authorize the Vice Chairman to sign the annual agreement with T.C. Engineering, Inc. for civil engineering services. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler and Bruns voted "aye". Nays, none. Woodruff absent.

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners recessed at 9:15 A.M. and the Lincoln County Board of Equalization convened.

Vice Chairman Weems announced the Open Meeting Act with amendments posted for public review and the county board will comply with the open meeting requirements.

County Assessor, Julie Stenger appeared.

Motion by Hewgley, seconded by Wuehler to approve the minutes regarding the Lincoln County Board of Equalization meeting held on February 13, 2023. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, and Wuehler voted "aye". Nays, none. Woodruff absent. Bruns abstained.

No certificates of correction or refund submitted by the County Assessor.

Motion by Hewgley, seconded by Bruns to approve the waiver for the late filing of a permissive exemption application submitted by Episcopal Church of our Savior. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler and Bruns voted "aye". Nays, none. Woodruff absent.

Motion by Bruns, seconded by Hewgley to approve the waiver for the late filing of a permissive exemption application submitted by Great Plains Health. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler and Bruns voted "aye". Nays, none. Woodruff absent.

The Lincoln County Board of Equalization adjourned at 9:28 A.M. and the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners reconvened.

Motion by Wuehler, seconded by Bruns to adopt Resolution No. 2023-04 that empowers the Lincoln County Noxious Weed Board to authorize purchases to be made by the Lincoln County Weed Superintendent in the amount not to exceed \$5000. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler and Bruns voted "aye". Nays, none. Woodruff absent.

Discussion was held concerning the Inland Port Authority application that was approved for Lincoln County. This selection will have a widespread positive impact and give greater access to markets. The next step for the county is to establish the actual authority which is a 9- member board. Bruns suggested the county create an application link for interested parties to apply on the county website. Following review of the applications, he suggested a short list be brought to the County Board for selection and appointment. The appointments will be revolving three -year terms. The county would be looking for particular logistics that would be beneficial on this board. The applicants must be a Lincoln County resident and have no financial interest in the property.

Commissioner Hewgley questioned who appointed or reappointed following board members.

Burns replied that as the terms expire the County Board is the one that appoints or reappoints board members.

Commissioner Weems reiterated that the County Board was in favor of the application to better the community and create other revenue sources rather than property tax.

Commissioner Wuehler was in favor of an application process to allow all residents of the county the opportunity to apply.

Commissioner Hewgley suggested advertising in as many forms as possible, not just the county website.

One bid was received for the Probation office remodel project located at 103-111 North Dewey as follows: Wayne Dowhower Construction, Inc. – Base bid - \$375,200.00 with the following alternates as listed. Alternate 1 – Renovation of the 111 N Dewey restroom – add \$14,200; Alternate 2 – Remove all painting – deduct \$29,200 and Alternate 3 – toggle switches in lieu of motion sensors – No bid.

Commissioner Weems stated that the bid is \$131,700 over the estimated project cost.

Commissioner Hewgley reviewed the plans and commented it appeared that demolition was included in the plans.

Wayne Dowhower Construction representatives confirmed that demolition was included in the bid.

Commissioner Bruns commented that a large portion of the demolition was already done by the county's building and grounds employees.

Dowhower Construction representatives replied that they would be willing to talk about the demolition cost included in the bid.

Lee Davies, the architect for the project and Commissioner Wuehler will contact Dowhower Construction this week. No action was taken, and this item was tabled until the next Commissioners meeting.
