Meeting of the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners. Present were Commissioners Joe Hewgley, Kent Weems, Micaela Wuehler, Chris Bruns, Jerry Woodruff and County Clerk, Rebecca Rossell. Weems offered prayer. Hewgley called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M.

Chairman Hewgley announced the Open Meeting Act with amendments is posted for public review and the county board will comply with the open meeting requirements.

Motion by Woodruff, seconded by Weems to approve the minutes regarding the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners meeting held on March 4, 2024. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.

Motion by Wuehler, seconded by Weems to receive and order filed the treasurer's receipts. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.

Motion by Bruns, seconded by Woodruff to receive and order fee reports submitted by the County Clerk for \$715.00, Register of Deeds for \$17,237.16 & Clerk of District Court for \$13,192.96. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.

Motion by Woodruff, seconded by Wuehler to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign the right-of-way application submitted by Dawson Public Power District as submitted. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners recessed at 9:15 A.M. and the Lincoln County Board of Equalization convened.

Chairman Hewgley announced the Open Meeting Act with amendments is posted for public review and the county board will comply with the open meeting requirements.

County Assessor, Julie Stenger appeared.

Motion by Wuehler, seconded by Weems to approve the minutes regarding the Lincoln County Board of Equalization meeting held on March 4, 2024. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.

No certificates of correction or refund submitted by the County Assessor.

The Lincoln County Board of Equalization recessed at 9:16 A.M. and the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners reconvened.

Motion by Wuehler, seconded by Bruns to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign the application No. 05 for the Sutherland North Bridge Project for \$352,946.97 as submitted. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.

Discussed two contract options with TextMyGov as current texting limit has been used and additional text messages are needed.

Motion by Bruns, seconded by Weems to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign and enter into a new three-year agreement with TextMyGov reflecting 300,000 messages included at \$9,500 annually to be effective immediately; invoicing month will be changed to February rather than June for a difference of \$1500.00 with the 20,000 initial messages gifted back to Lincoln County. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.

Commissioner Bruns gave an update on the RAISE grant application. He explained merit criteria that would be used to evaluate the application for selection and a possible timeline if the application is successful.

Commissioner Wuehler asked if there would be a local match if the grant is successful.

Commissioner Bruns replied there would be no match.

Planning Director, Judy Clark, reported we are ready to set a date to accept bids for the project selected at the LC Dept. of Roads shop which will use the \$76,200 in EECBG grants funds the county was awarded. There is no local match for the grant. Jason Schultz will put out the advertisement for bidders. Clark suggested having the bid done in two separate bids. One bid for demolition and one bid for construction.

Motion by Woodruff, seconded by Bruns to set April 15, 2024, at 10:00 A.M. to accept bids for the EECBG grant project at Lincoln County Department of Roads main shop. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.

Discussion was held on how the county could support Range Fire Mitigation & Response in Lincoln County. Fire Chief Dennis Thompson, Assistant Fire Chief Trent Kleinow and County Sheriff Jerome Kramer were present for discussion. Thompson stated he appreciated starting the conversation early to see how the county can assist. He reported the town hall meetings held last week helped them to gain information and ideas. Life safety is their top priority and water supply is the big thing for them. There is good cooperation with other agencies and organizations including the Lincoln County Sheriff's Department.

Commissioner Bruns suggested training for the LC Road Dept. heavy equipment operators and placement of proper signage.

Commissioner Wuehler is establishing a voluntary registry for rapid fill pumps in the county. Heavy equipment operator fire training would be a good investment for the county.

Commissioner Weems asked about an issue with communication between fire command and locals with fire mitigation equipment.

Sheriff Kramer responded that his department works with the fire department now and they have protocols.

Commissioner Woodruff suggested the use of ARPA funds for fire training classes for road crew operators. He also questioned if there is adequate communication between Lincoln County Department of Roads and fire command.

Commissioner Hewgley commented that communication has been an on-going issue between fire command and multiple departments.

Chief Thompson responded the state radio system does tie them together, but rural fire departments got left behind.

Chief Deputy Kleinow reported that with the Betty's Way Fire there was no cell service as they were out of range. Managing the communication process can be challenging as mutual aid is needed regularly now.

Chairman Hewgley appointed Commissioners Woodruff and Wuehler to the Range Fire Mitigation and Response committee.

Recess as the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners and reconvene as the Lincoln County Board of Equalization at 10:37 A.M.

A public hearing was opened at 10:38 A.M. to receive comments on tax exemption applications on real & personal property submitted to the County Assessor.

County Assessor, Julie Stenger, gave comments on those parcels that she recommended partial approval or denial.

John Sexson provided information on the Lonestar Cowboy Church of North Platte. Bible study has been held weekly since last fall at the location on the exemption application. The building is still being renovated.

Commissioner Weems asked if the board could portion off one acre on the parcel that included the building and parking area.

Stenger replied that would be correct.

Matthew Peyton appeared for Wallace Community Church. They have held prayer services 5 or 6 times at the site on the application. It is a future building site for a church.

Stenger stated that by law vacant lots are not eligible for exemption.

Summer Owen, CFO at Great Plain Health was present.

Stenger asked if all the locations personnel were employees of the hospital.

Owen replied yes.

Stenger questioned what the policy is at the locations when patients can't pay for services.

Owen responded that there is the same financial assistance policy at all locations. There is a sliding fee schedule based on the federal poverty limit.

Stenger wanted to know if there is a fee to the hospital separate from the provider's fee.

Yes, per Owen. She stated that it is a common practice.

Stenger then asked if patients were referred to collection for non-payment.

Owen replied yes.

Commissioner Bruns asked if the hospital had comparable pricing to other competitors.

Owen again responded yes.

Commissioner Wuehler confirmed that none of these locations would deny access to health care based on the ability to pay.

Owen replied in the affirmative.

Paul Orr asked for a copy of the state statute referring to religious exemptions.

The public hearing was closed at 11:49 A.M.

The County Board of Equalization recessed at 11:49 A.M. and reconvened at 11:56 A.M.
