EXHIBIT A

On September 6, 2022 the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners adopted a black-tailed prairie dog management plan pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 23-3803 which provides for the management of unwanted or nuisance black-tailed prairie dog colonies through voluntary and forced control measures. State law specifies a duty of each person who owns or controls property within a county that has adopted a coordinated program for the management of black-tailed prairie dogs under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 23-3803 to manage black-tailed prairie dog colonies present upon their property to prevent the expansion of colonies to adjacent property unless the owner of the adjacent property waives objection in writing to such expansion.
