Meeting of the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners. Present were Commissioners Joe Hewgley, Kent Weems, Micaela Wuehler, Chris Bruns, Jerry Woodruff and County Clerk Rebecca Rossell. Hewgley offered prayer. Wuehler called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M.

Chairwoman Wuehler announced the Open Meeting Act with amendments is posted for public review and the county board will comply with the open meeting requirements.

Motion by Hewgley, seconded by Woodruff to approve the minutes regarding the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners meeting held on June 23, 2025. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.

Motion by Bruns, seconded by Woodruff to receive and order filed the treasurer's receipts. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.

Motion by Hewgley, seconded by Bruns to authorize the Chair to sign an annual agreement for legal services with Martin Troshynski for \$99,000. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.

Motion by Weems, seconded by Bruns, to authorize the Chair to sign an annual agreement for legal services with William Troshynski for \$54,000. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners recessed at 9:15 A.M. and the Lincoln County Board of Equalization convened.

The Lincoln County Board of Equalization adjourned at 9:18 A.M. and the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners reconvened.



Motion by Weems, seconded by Hewgley to approve the appointment of Erin Arensdorf as the spirited individual to West Central District Health Department for a 2-year term to end in January 2027. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.

Update by Jon Cannon, Executive Director, Nebraska Association of County Officials (NACO).

Commissioner Wuehler gave an update on recent changes to the Nebraska BEAD (Broadband Equity, Access and Deployment Program) DPA (defined project area) Map. The original funding approved for Nebraska was \$405 million which would serve 15,299 addresses. The new map has a 52% decrease in addresses that would be served. Lincoln County had a 23% decrease in addresses locally.

A letter to Nebraska and Congressional officials concerning NBEAD (Nebraska Broadband Equity, Access and Deployment Program) map update concerns will be drafted and edited and put on the next county board agenda.

Update from Jason Schultz, Lincoln County Highway Supt. on recent storms and road closures due to weather related issues. They had to close S Hidden Lakes Rd and Antelope Road.
