Meeting of the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners. Present were Commissioners Joe Hewgley, Kent Weems, Micaela Wuehler, Chris Bruns, Jerry Woodruff and Deputy County Clerk, Nicole Fisher. Bruns offered prayer. Wuehler called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M.

Chairwoman Wuehler announced the Open Meeting Act with amendments is posted for public review and the county board will comply with the open meeting requirements.

Motion by Woodruff, seconded by Hewgley to approve the minutes regarding the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners meeting held on November 3, 2025. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none. Bruns abstained.

Motion by Bruns seconded by Woodruff to receive and order filed the treasurer's receipts. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners recessed at 9:15 A.M. and the Lincoln County Board of Equalization convened.

Chairwoman Wuehler announced the Open Meeting Act with amendments is posted for public review and the county board will comply with the open meeting requirements.

County Assessor, Julie Stenger appeared.

Motion by Hewgley, seconded by Weems to approve the minutes regarding the Lincoln County Board of Equalization meeting held on November 3, 2025. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none. Bruns abstained.

No certificates of correction or refund submitted by the County Assessor.

Motion by Hewgley, seconded by Weems, to approve the motor vehicle tax exemption application submitted by North Platte Baptist Church and recommended for approval by the County Treasurer. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.

The Lincoln County Board of Equalization adjourned at 9:18 A.M. and the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners reconvened.

Motion by Weems, seconded by Bruns, to approve the chair to sign the Memorandum of Understanding between NE Dept. Of Veteran’s Affairs and Lincoln County. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted “aye”. Nays, none.

Motion by Woodruff, seconded by Hewgley, to approve the purchase of a tandem snow-plow truck for Lincoln County Department of Roads from Master Tech Truck & Equipment in the amount of \$312,183.00. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted “aye”. Nays, none.

Discussion was held concerning the interlocal agreement for Network Services with the City of North Platte. This item was tabled until November 17th, 2025 for further research.

Lincoln County Department of Roads Superintendent, Jason Schultz appeared.

Discussion was held concerning the interlocal agreement for Maintenance of Roads with the City of North Platte. Hewgley suggested that miles be compared between the county and city to make sure the agreement was not one-sided. It was decided that the Roads Committee will look into it further.

This item was tabled for further research.
