Meeting of the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners. Present were Commissioners Joe Hewgley, Kent Weems, Micaela Wuehler, Chris Bruns, Jerry Woodruff and County Clerk, Rebecca Rossell. Wuehler offered prayer. Wuehler called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M.

Chairwoman Wuehler announced the Open Meeting Act with amendments is posted for public review and the county board will comply with the open meeting requirements.

Motion by Woodruff, seconded by Bruns to approve the minutes regarding the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners meeting held on December 1, 2025. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.

No public comments were received.

Motion by Bruns, seconded by Hewgley to receive and order filed the treasurer's receipts. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.

Motion by Bruns, seconded by Woodruff to receive and order filed the fee reports submitted by the Clerk of District for \$4103.32 and Register of Deeds for \$24,283.99. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted "aye". Nays, none.

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners recessed at 9:15 A.M. and the Lincoln County Board of Equalization convened.

No certificates of correction or refund submitted by the County Assessor.

The Lincoln County Board of Equalization adjourned at 9:19 A.M. and the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners reconvened.

Motion by Woodruff, seconded by Bruns to authorize the Chair to sign the NE Crime Commission Fiscal Year 2027 Community-based Juvenile Services Aid Application for



\$110,802. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted “aye”. Nays, none.

Motion by Weems, seconded by Hewgley to authorize the Chair to sign the 2025 Community-based Juvenile Services Aid Alternative to Detention Form for \$3420.00 for one time use for the purchase of a door for the juvenile detention center. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted “aye”. Nays, none.

Planning Director, Judy Clark, gave an update on the Lincoln County Comprehensive Plan & Zoning Regulations.

Motion by Weems, seconded by Woodruff to approve the application by Randy & Sharalyn Ayers for Ayers First Subdivision located at 8184 South Buffalo Road in an R-2 Urban Estates District on property described as part of the E ½ of Section 31; Township 13 North; Range 30 W of the 6th P.M., Lincoln County, Nebraska. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted “aye”. Nays, none.

Motion by Bruns, seconded by Weems to adopt Resolution No. 2025-33 authorizing the Chair to sign the Year-End Certification of County Highway Supt. 2025. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted “aye”. Nays, none.

Discuss purchasing two motor graders for the Lincoln County Dept. of Roads. The following bids were received: NMC – 2 Cat 140AWD @ \$372,800 each; Murphy Tractor – 2 John Deere 672P @ \$379,326.65.

Motion by Hewgley, seconded by Woodruff to accept the bid of NMC for two 140AWD graders for a total amount of \$656,350.00 with trade allowance as recommended by the Highway Supt. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted “aye”. Nays, none.

Chairwoman Wuehler appointed Commissioners Bruns & Commissioner Hewgley to the interlocal agreement committee.

The study on Vieyra Avenue was received from the Lincoln County Highway Supt.

Motion by Woodruff, seconded by Hewgley to adopt Resolution No. 2025-34 setting January 12, 2026, at 9:30 A.M. for a public hearing on the potential vacation of Vieyra Avenue. Upon roll call vote Hewgley, Weems, Wuehler, Bruns and Woodruff voted “aye”. Nays, none.
